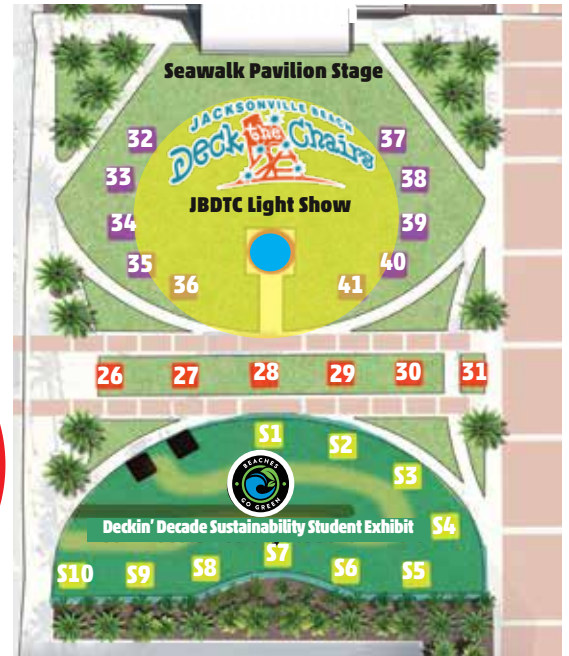

CHAIRS PROVIDED WITH DESIGN GUIDELINES

- Designs must be submitted for review and approval.
- Chair designs will exist within a 15-ft by 15-ft area and should not exceed 12-ft in height.
- Exhibit must be able to withstand North Florida oceanfront weather for six weeks including 30 plus mile per hour winds, heavy rain and hot beating sun.
- Sponsor will be responsible for all construction material purchases unless otherwise subcontracted.
- Approved materials include: wood, plastics, PVC, vinyl, metal fittings, chicken wire and lights. Fasteners are limited to zip ties, clamps and wood screws. NO glues, tapes or pre-made decorations without approval.
- Maintenance and lighting of the exhibit, extension cords and weights are the responsibility of the school.
- Chairs may not be modified or damaged in such that they will be deemed unusable.
- Sponsor is responsible for meeting all deadlines and artistic guidelines.
